

Halloween Trail 2020 guidelines

Please only book if you agree to follow these guidelines

All tickets MUST be purchased in advance. You will not be admitted to the site without a valid ticket.

Parking

Sorry, there is no parking at the Scouts & Guides HQ. If you are coming in a car, please park in the Haverhill Arts Centre car park off Duddery Hill or the Meadows car park off Ehringshausen Way. Colne Valley Road is a two – three minute walk. Please do not park in the residential roads close to the site.

Start time

The time shown on your ticket is the time we need you to arrive to join the (socially distanced) queue. Please arrive at your start time or up to ten minutes after. This will allow us to limit the numbers on site at any one time and reduce the overall time you will be waiting to join the Halloween Trail. We expect your queue time to be between 10 and 15 minutes.

On arrival please join the queue and wait for a steward to scan your ticket.

Masks and face coverings

Please wear your mask. Children under 11 do not have to wear a mask unless they want to.

Bubbles

Bubbles of up to six people and from two household can be booked. Bubbles must stick together as they go around the trail.

Restricted tickets

Please do not buy more than one set/bubble of tickets. We need to comply with the government guidelines as full as possible to be able to keep operating in the future.

Fancy dress

If you want to get into the Halloween spirit we'd love to see your best spooky outfits. However, don't forget it is October! Please make sure you stay warm and dry. Sturdy footwear is advised.

Accessibility

In normal circumstances the site is accessible for wheelchairs and pushchairs. However, if the weather is wet accessibility may be impaired

Photography

We may take photography for publicity purposes. If you wish not to have your photograph used please inform an event steward.

Stewards

Haverhill Town Council stewards will be on hand to help keep social distancing measures in place. We expect all participants to follow our event guidelines and those set out by the government but, in order to safeguard our staff, we will not ask them to take enforcement measures.

Toilets

Sorry, there are no public toilets on site.

Be kind to local residents

Please work with our stewards to enter and exit the site safely and with respect to local residents. And, of course take any rubbish home with you.
